

Maple Country NWTF Coyote Open Contest Rules

1. All Ohio Hunting Regulations must be followed.
2. Coyotes must be harvested with firearm or bow
3. No trapping or snaring of coyote will be allowed
4. All teams must be registered by one member of team prior to 7:00 pm 3-11-2010
5. Entry fee is \$50.00 per 2 man team
6. Contest hours are from sunrise 3-12-2010 to ½ hour before sunset 3-14-2010
7. Coyotes harvested 3-12 and 3-13 must be certified on day of harvest at one of two check stations between 7:00pm and 9:00 pm.
8. **Check station locations are:**
 - Burton Log Cabin, Downtown Burton, on the Square**
 - Trumbull Locker Plant, 3393 St Rt 534, Rock Creek Ohio**
9. Coyotes harvested 3-14 will be certified prior to weigh in.
10. Weigh in time is 7:00 pm on 3-14-2010
11. **Weigh in location: Geauga County Coon Hunters Club, 17131 Peters Rd Middlefield, Ohio 44062**
12. Awards are as follows:
 - 1st Place: Most coyotes harvested, \$300.00
 - 2nd Place: Heaviest Coyote Harvested, \$100.00
 - 3rd Place: Longest Coyote Harvested, \$100.00 (measured from tip of nose to tip of tail)
13. Tie Breaker will be determined by longest canine in place
14. Any coyote suspected of being illegally harvested will be refused.
15. Any Coyote suspected of being unnaturally weighted will be subjected to dissection at the discretion of the judges
16. All harvested coyote will be returned to the hunter. Hunter is responsible for disposal of coyote
17. Maple Country Chapter will at their discretion based on number of contestants increase the prize purse. Minimum Pay Out will be \$500.00
18. Additional funds generated will go toward funding Maple Country Chapter future events such as Youth Hunts, Handicap Hunts, Habitat Improvements at our discretion
